Dear Spartan Fans,

Next week, our program will transition into our "Spring Drills" phase. On Monday, May 4th, we will take the field during 6th hour for organized football drills with helmets on. We will practice for 60 minutes during this period. The Spring Drills phase is where we install our base concepts and teach our players our expectations for practice tempo and transitions. This phase will last for two weeks and will lead us into official spring practice beginning Monday, May 18th.

We intentionally wait to begin official spring practice until after the state baseball tournament and track meet. This ensures that all of our multi-sport athletes have completed their spring seasons. We are allowed 10 padded practices, culminating in our Spring Game on Friday, May 29th at 6:00 PM. Admission to the Spring Game is one case of Gatorade, which we will use throughout the summer and fall. This is a tremendous help in reducing the financial burden on our Quarterback Club each season.

Following spring football practice, we will host one of the best team camps in the country. On June 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, we will host East St. Louis, Edmond Memorial, Broken Arrow, Tulsa Washington, and Lawton. Our annual team camp has become the premier camp in Oklahoma. We divide into four squads, allowing our players to get a high volume of quality reps against some of the best competition in the region. This camp is essential to our players' development.

Coaches consistently tell us that Bixby is the first place in Oklahoma they visit. We continue to be thankful for our outstanding football facility. We believe we have the best locker room, meeting rooms, and coaches' offices in the country. Our players and coaches are doing a great job utilizing the space, keeping it like new, and maximizing the efficiency it provides. We are grateful that our patrons recognize the impact football has on so many student-athletes and the positive influence it has on their lives.

2026 continues to be another record-breaking year in our weight room. More athletes than ever are pushing the envelope and setting personal records. We currently have more players cleaning 225 pounds than at any point this early in the season in program history. Credit goes to our three certified strength and conditioning coaches for their intentional, year-round programming.

Mr. Vernon, our middle school principal, has recently approved an expansion of our middle school strength and conditioning program. We have added another hour of Strength and Conditioning, allowing student-athletes to take the class even if they are enrolled in multiple sports. This addition will take our already elite strength culture to an even higher level. [S.P.A. \(Speed, Power, Agility\)](#) is another critical component of our busy summers and will begin Monday, June 15th. Training runs Monday through Thursday. Our 8th–12th graders train from 7:00–9:00 AM, and our 1st–7th graders (boys and girls) train from 9:30–11:00 AM. We will once again offer our summer feeding program, providing free meals for all participants following workouts. Consistency is one of our core values, so we reward varsity players who achieve perfect attendance with a steak dinner—these athletes are known as “Steak Eaters.”

As Spring Ball approaches and winter off-season training is winding down, we have seen the team as a whole make significant progress. Overall, collective numbers in the weight room and on the field have been trending in a great direction, resulting in a group that will be ready to hit the ground running for spring ball.

As this off-season training block comes to a close, there will be a small drop in overall training volume in the weight room, emphasizing the work we are doing in spring football practice. Intensities and speeds in the weight room will remain high to maintain and continue to build strength and power to display on the field, as well as reducing the risk for injury. Ensuring that our athletes are exposed to proper intensities in the weight room in the correct volume range, will allow us to stay fresh through spring ball, while still building to then transition into summer training.

Going forward, we will have one more testing period to get accurate numbers to train from for squat, bench and clean prior to spring practice starting. Listed below are some of the top lifts and jumps we have seen over the course of winter training.

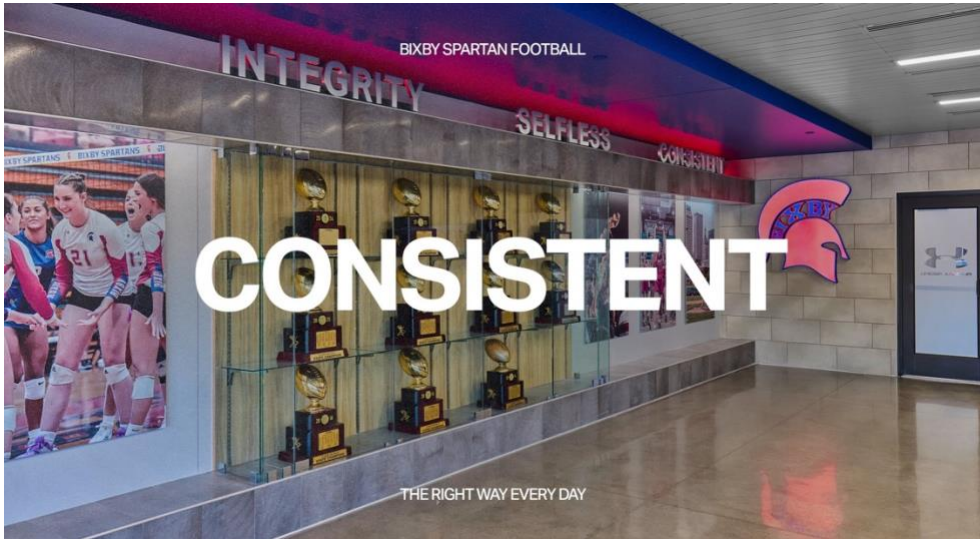
